

Your Data – Register of Bikes

- Bike parking is provided free of charge for persons travelling on services from SPT Subway or Bus stations (“**SPT Stations**”) in accordance with SPT’s Bike Parking Terms and Conditions which can be found at: spt.co.uk/walking-and-cycling/.
- Any bike left overnight at the cycle parking facilities may, at the sole discretion of SPT, be moved to safe storage for a period of two (2) weeks to allow the owner to come forward and claim the bike.
- To claim an abandoned bike, you must contact SPT by email enquiry@spt.co.uk, by telephone on 0141 332 6811, or by post at Strathclyde Partnership for Transport, 131 St Vincent Street, Glasgow, G2 5JF.
- SPT will collect and use need to collect and use the personal information that you provide when you submit your claim to an abandoned cycle and in any subsequent correspondence with SPT if you, in order to alerting us to a matter that you want SPT to address or respond to and to administer the register of cycles. Such personal information may include:
 - Your full name;
 - Full postal address;
 - E-mail address;
 - Telephone number; and
 - Other personal information that you choose to provide to use in the course of your correspondence to SPT.
- As and when any changes are made to the information SPT receives from you in connection with the SPT Register of Bikes, this privacy notice will be updated.
