Proposed awards of subsidised local bus service contracts

1. Object of report

To recommend the Partnership approves the award of a number of subsidised local bus service contracts.

This paper affects the East Dunbartonshire, East Renfrewshire, Glasgow City, North Lanarkshire, South Lanarkshire and West Dunbartonshire council areas.

2. Background

Members have been provided with a report to the Partnership outlining the background to recent contract awards and subsequent circumstance surrounding the need to re-tender three specific services as detailed in the report. This resulted in the need to yet again retender services, and given the initial tender prices received, centrally review both the service provision, value for money and affordability.

3. Current Position

Attached at Appendix 1 are the proposed award of contracts to replace the three contracts referenced in the previous paper. Members attention is drawn to the increased costs of these contracts, following the original decision. In addition, to address further changes in the commercial market, two further contracts to maintain social links are proposed.

Given the marked increase in costs and the circumstances surrounding the need to retender, it is essential that SPT undertake a more detailed analysis of the network in the area affected. Details of this will be reported to a future committee.

The proposed awards value at Appendix 1 is £9,057,340 over the duration of the contracts, equating to additional annual costs of £506,705. Whilst this can be accommodated in the current year budget, it does minimise the scope to address any unexpected market changes. These matters will continue to be monitored.

4. Recommendation

The Partnership is recommended to agree the award of the contracts detailed in Appendix 1.
