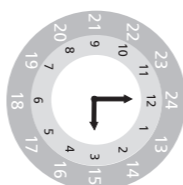

Route service 416: From Coatbridge via Sunnyside Road, Dunbeth Road, B804,Coatbank Street, Whifflet Street, Calder Street, Sikeside Street, Sykeside Road, Calderbank Road, Calderbank Main Street, Woodhall Mill Road, Bo'ness Road, McNeil Drive, Townhead Avenue, Parklands Avenue, Parklands Way, Maxim, Townhead Avenue, McNeil Drive, Bo'ness Road, Holytown Main Street, Holytown Road, Mossend Main Street, Campbell Street, North Road, Hamilton Road, Neilson Street, Motherwell Road, Bellshill Main Street, North Road, Gartcosh Walk, Belgrave Street, Unnamed Road to Pheonix Crescent, **Strathclyde Business Park**.
Return journey from **Pheonix Crescent**, Strathclyde Business Park via reverse of above route to North Road then via Hamilton Road, Neilson Street, Motherwell Road, Bellshill Main Street, North Road then via above route to Maxim then Parklands Way, Parklands Avenue, Townhead Avenue, A8 for Edinburgh, off slip to Woodhall Mill Road then reverse of above route to Coatbank Street, B804 to Coatbridge, Sunnyside Road, South Circular Road, **Sunnyside Road, Coatbridge**.
Journeys direct from Coatbridge to Bellshill Station via South Circular Road then normal route to Whifflet Street then North Road, Hamilton Road, Neilson Street to Motherwell Road, Bellshill then via normal route to Maxim and Coatbridge Sunnyside Road.

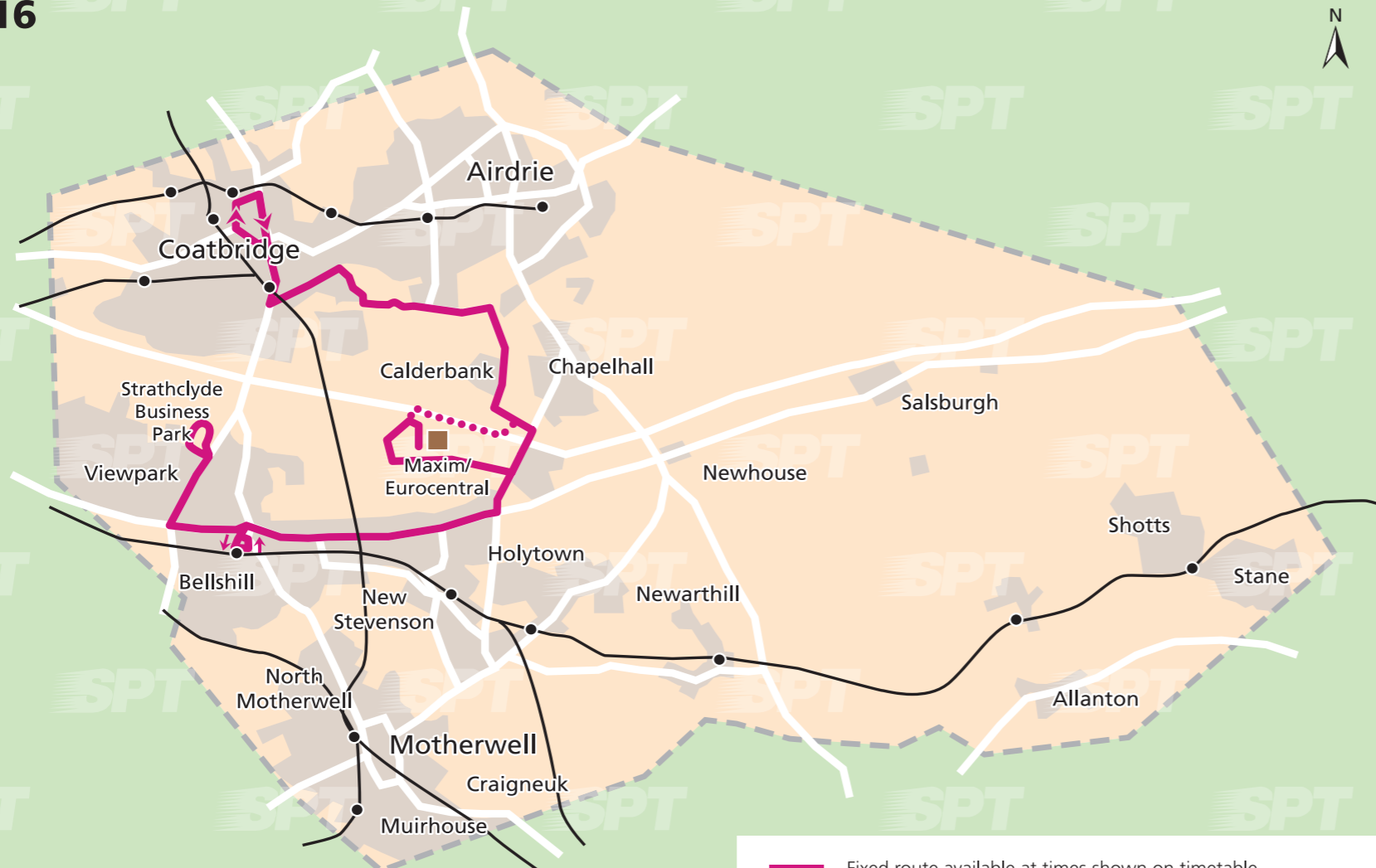

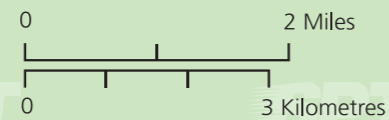

What is the demand responsive part of this bus service?

- Demand responsive transport is an innovative bus service that picks you up from a centrally located area near your home and takes you to and from work at Maxim/Eurocentral at a time that suits you. Whilst every effort will be made to provide a direct service, once travel patterns emerge, journeys with interchange may be considered.
- It does not make trips where there are alternative public transport services unless you have mobility difficulties.
- The bus will be in operation between 0950 – 1500 hours and 1800 – 2230 hours Monday to Friday.

Who can use it?

- The service is available to everyone travelling to/from Maxim and Eurocentral area to/from within the marked area on the map.
- Like conventional bus services, the service is available to everyone but group bookings are also welcome.
- As travel patterns emerge through regular bookings, it may be possible to arrange fixed times on this service.

How do I use the service?

- Bookings are accepted on a first come first served basis.
- Booking is easy. All it takes is a simple call to the booking line on 0845 128 4027 to register for the service. Journeys can be booked by text message, although these must be sent during the booking hours and SPT will respond by text advising of availability.

- Bookings can be made up to 2 hours before travelling, but we recommend you book the day before. Monday journeys should be booked on Fridays.
- The booking line is open 0900 – 1600 hours Monday to Thursday and 0900 – 1530 hours Fridays.
- Scottish Citizens National Entitlement Cards, Zonecards and Daytripper tickets are valid on the service.

Fares

- Normal bus fares apply. Please check your fare at the time of booking.

Journey Times

- Every effort will be made to offer you your requested travel times but this is subject to availability.
- If a number of passengers are going to the same destination we may offer you these times. A note of your shift times will assist booking staff with this.
- We may have to change your booking times but will advise you if these changes exceed 10 minutes. Please ensure you provide reliable contact details for this purpose and check for messages.
- Other passengers are often picked up en route to your destination. Please allow sufficient time for this when booking your journey.
