- 1 **First 92:** from/to - Drumchapel - Anniesland - Partick, Merkland Street
- 2, 3 **First 118/A:** from/to - Buchanan Bus Station - Anniesland - Duntocher

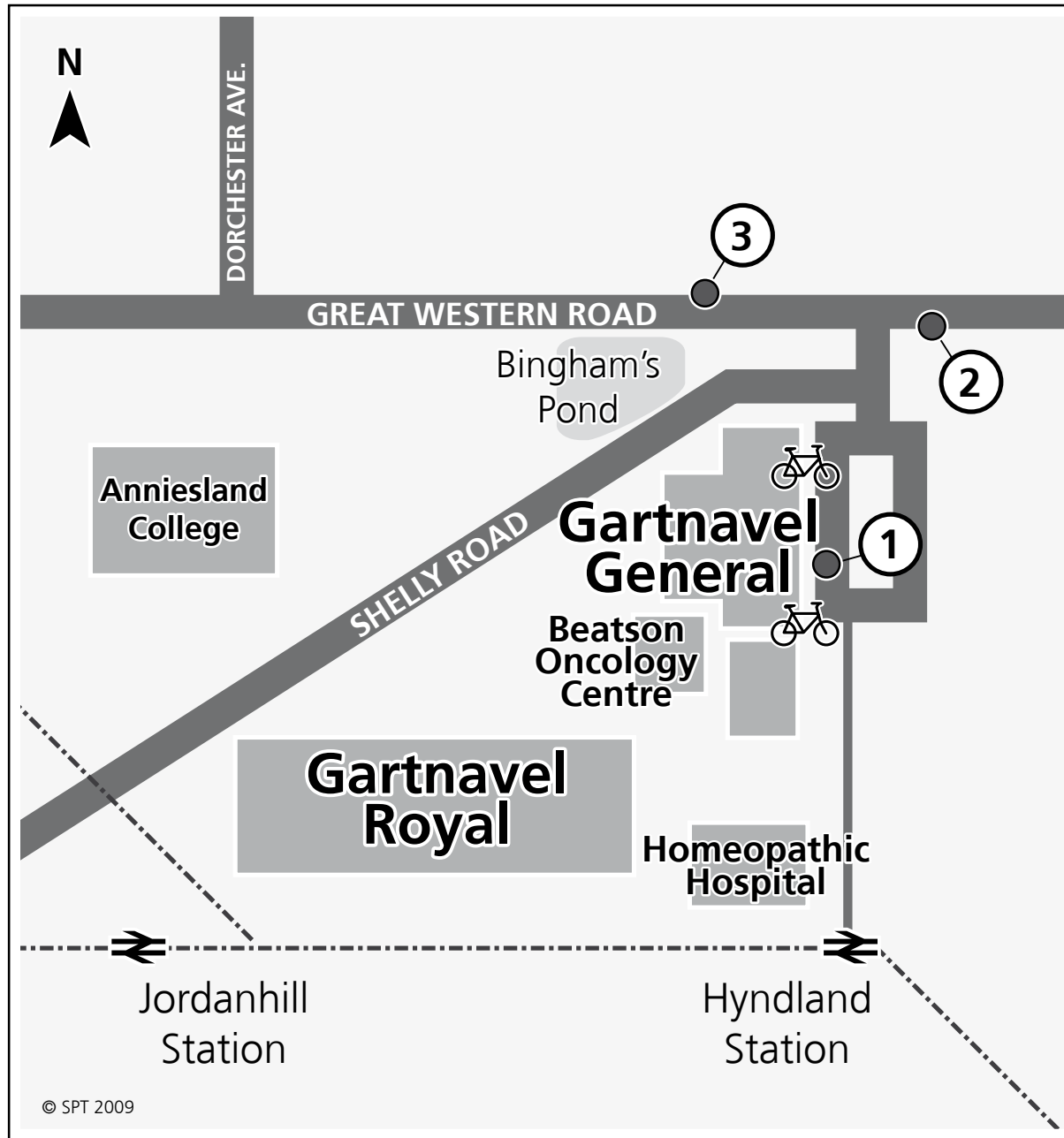
