

### Introduction

Greenock bus station is an on street bus station with 8 bus stances.

### Location

The station is located on Kilblain Street in Greenock town centre.

It is surrounded by Stewart Centre to the west and a B&M store to the east. Nicolson Street to the north and High Street/Inverkip Street to the south.

Additional bus stances, which are not part of the bus station, are located on Nicolson Street.

Both Nicolson Street and Kilblain Street can only be used by buses.


Kilblain Street has additional traffic lanes between the bus station and the Stewart Centre. This road provides access to local business and houses only.

## **Opening hours**


The bus stances and the areas around them can be accessed 24hrs a day, 7 days a week.

# **Greenock Bus Station** concourse description

### Arriving at the station

Arriving on foot, the bus station area can only be accessed from the pavement on Kilblain Street. Railings prevent pedestrians accessing the bus operational area except at bus boarding and pedestrian crossing points.

Uncontrolled pedestrian crossings provide access to either side of the bus station. These are located at both ends of the bus station.

The crossing at the Nicolson Street end has a refuge island in the middle. This island also connects across Nicolson Street and Kilhlain Street.

There is an additional crossing point on Kilblain Street at stance 3, which provides access to stances 1-4.

Crossings are identified with yellow blister paving tiles, dropped kerbs and gaps in the pedestrian railings.

A taxi rank is also situated on West Stewart Street. This is a very short distance walk from the stance area.

There is a long stay car park next to the bus station on Hastie Street.

Bike racks are available adjacent to stance 8.

### **Bus stances**

All areas of the bus station are step free. In addition, light colored wayfinding slabs help to guide travelers from crossing points to the stance shelters and then stance boarding points.

When entering from the Nicolson Street end, stances 1-4 are on the left of the bus station and stances 5-8 are on the right. The buses pass between the two rows of stances.

Both rows of bus stances have fully enclosed waiting areas with seats at each stance.

Stances 1-4 and stances 5-8 can be accessed through doors in the north end of the waiting area at end (Nicolson Street).

At the south end (High Street/Inverkip Street), stances 1-4 can also be accessed from Kilblain Street and the Stewart Centre between stances 3 and 4.

Stances 5-8 can be accessed from the pavement between B&M and the bus waiting area at stance 5.

All entrances to the waiting areas are controlled by automatic sliding doors.

All stances are lit. Each stance has talking signs and information screens that give information on the next departure and stance number.

### **Toilets**

There are no toilets within the bus station area.

### Other information

There is full CCTV coverage throughout the station for the safety and security of all travellers.

Free WiFi is available when connecting to 'SPT Free WiFi'.

There are no facilities for left luggage.

Tickets cannot be purchased at this bus station. All bus tickets should either be purchased in advance through the bus operator or on the vehicle from the driver
