1. Object of report

To recommend the Committee note the requests received for subsidised local bus services and approves the recommended actions.

(a) to provide a bus service along Kennedy Drive, Helensburgh. **Recommend:** No action, Sinclair Street, Helensburgh is within a walking distance considered acceptable under SPT guideline criteria and the level of service frequency at this location is adequate.

(b) to provide additional bus services in Carrickstone, Cumbernauld and in the areas north of the M80, with specific emphasis on direct provision to Glasgow. **Recommend**: No action, suitable frequency of service exists within the areas, as considered acceptable under SPT guideline criteria, providing connections to Cumbernauld town centre and Croy Rail Station, where interchange is available for onward travel.
