1. Declaration of interest in terms of the Ethical Standards in Public Life etc (Scotland) Act 2000

3. Exclusion of press and public

4. Appeal against dismissal (SPT20)

The Sub-Committee heard both parties fully on the case and after questions, both parties withdrew.

Following consideration of the appeal and having heard and considered carefully all the documents and evidence, the Sub-Committee found that the grounds for the appeal had not been substantiated and the appeal was not upheld.

Thereafter, the appellant and their representative, together with SPT's representative, were readmitted to the meeting and advised of the Sub-Committee's decision.
