1. Grant funding of constituent authorities

With reference to the Strategy and Programmes Committee earlier that day when the committee had considered and approved a report (issued) of 25 January 2007 by the Assistant Chief Executive (Business Support)

- (1) intimating
 - (a) that in November 2006, SPT had received formal notification of an award of additional revenue funding, in the sum of £530,000, from the Scottish Executive in respect of feasibility studies for specific projects in partnership with constituent authorities; and
 - (b) that, in addition, constituent authorities had been asked to identify any further capital projects for inclusion in the 2006/07 programme in anticipation of a potential year end downturn in the overall SPT programme, mainly as a result of the Partick Interchange project delay;
- appending a list of feasibility studies, together with a list of constituent authority capital bids; and
- (3) recommending, inter alia, that the Chair's Committee
 - (a) approve grant funding to Glasgow City Council in the sum of £200,000, which was above the Strategy & Programmes Committee approval level; and
 - (b) be asked to consider and approve those capital projects which required further information,

there was tabled a summary list of the capital projects and costs referred to at 3(b) above.

After consideration, the committee approved

- (i) grant funding to Glasgow City Council in the sum of £200,000;
- (ii) the list of capital bids from constituent councils tabled at the meeting; and

(iii) grant funding to the various councils in respect of the projects at (ii) above.
