1. Apologies

2. Declaration of interest in terms of the Ethical Standards in Public Life etc (Scotland) Act 2000

The committee noted that there were no declarations of interest.

3. Proposed Award of Contract

The Chair and Vice Chair's considered information outlining a recent application from South Ayrshire Community Transport (SACT) for an additional grant of £45,000 to extend the provision of Community Transport in South Ayrshire, as outlined below;

- (1) provision of a Demand Responsive Transport service in the Carrick area of South Ayrshire, utilising a wheelchair-accessible people carrier vehicle. This will replace MyBus rural service R700 which ceases on Saturday 14th July; and
- (2) provision of an additional day per week of operation of Community Bus service CB8, which operates between Barr & Girvan, utilising the existing vehicle.

To ensure continuity, the Chair and Vice Chair's:

- (i) noted that this provision saves SPT £81,000 per year compared with the R700 provision which ceases on Saturday 14th July;
- (ii) noted that in the current financial year SPT have to date funded SACT £43,845, consisting, £33,845 core funding and £10,000 towards service CB8; and
- (iii) thereon approved the award of the grant as detailed.
