Applications for grant funding - community transport

Report by Chief Executive

1. Object of report

To request the Committee approve grant funding in support of a project delivered by Coalfield Community Transport.

2. Background to report

Community Transport operators deliver much needed transport to the local communities and voluntary groups, particularly the elderly, disabled and those on low income. These services are designed to promote and support the delivery of high quality, reliable and accessible transport to communities across the SPT area.

3. Outline of proposals

An application for funding has been received from Coalfield Community Transport (CCT) for funding towards the purchase of a new 16 seat wheelchair accessible minibus, convertible to carry up to five wheelchairs. CCT have experienced an uplift in demand for their services, both from additional groups in their own immediate area (Cumnock) and from several groups further afield in the northern area of East Ayrshire. This additional vehicle, joining CCT's fleet of 11 vehicles, would allow groups in that part of East Ayrshire to be able to use the vehicle, avoiding the cost of having to use a vehicle from CCT's Cumnock base. In addition, CCT are exploring the extension of their provision into the North Ayrshire area, and this vehicle would support that expansion. The financial support sought is up to £75,000 towards the purchase of an additional vehicle.

4. Committee action

The Operations Committee is recommended to approve grant funding of up to £75,000 to Coalfield Community Transport.

All grants are subject to appropriate governance checks being carried out.

5. Consequences
