Bus Station Access Guide

Introduction

Govan Bus station is a modern purpose-built station with 7 bus stances.

Location

The station is in Govan town centre, beside Govan Subway station and to the east of Govan Cross Shopping Centre.

The station is bordered by the area of public realm beside Subway station, off Govan Road, to the north and Golspie Street to the south and east.

Opening hours

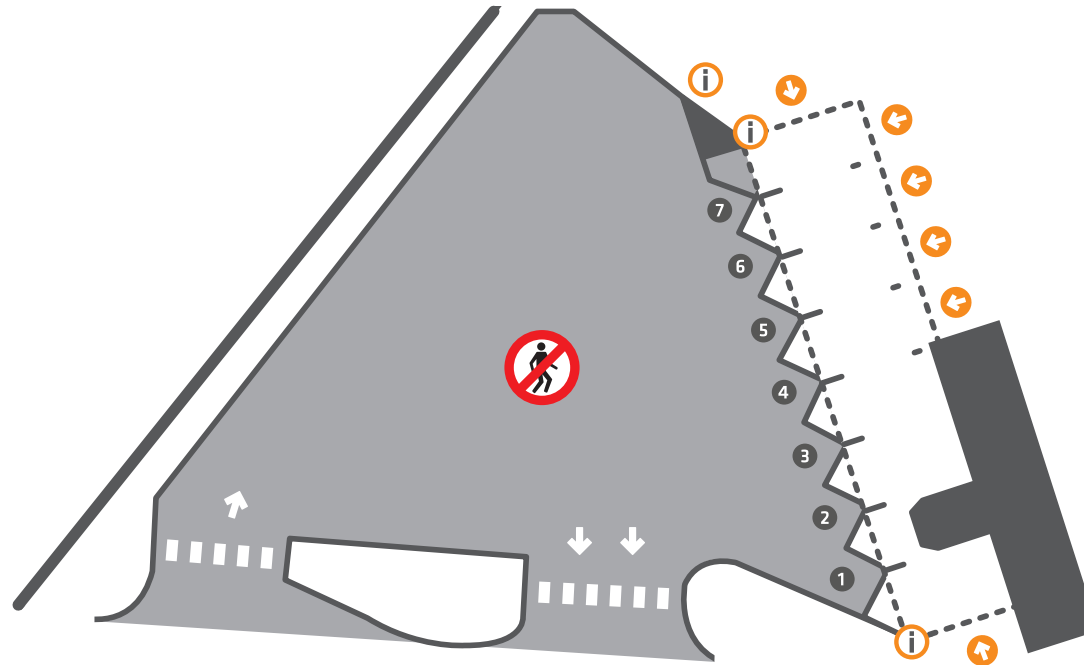
The bus stances and the areas around them can be accessed 24hrs a day, 7 days a week.

Staff presence

There are no staff at this bus station.

Govan Bus Station concourse description

Access to the bus station and bus stances

There is level, step free access to all stances and throughout the surrounding area of public realm.

The bus station is formed by one row of bus stances along the north side of the bus station operational area, right beside Govan Subway station.

The bus stances are accessed from Golspie Street to the south and via the area of public realm off Govan Road, to the north.

Bus stances

The bus stances are enclosed on three sides, with the side facing Govan Road open.

The roof over the stances extends to create a covered walkway along the length of the stances.

All stances have automatic sliding doors that open when a bus arrives at the stance.

The sliding doors and fences prevent access to the operational area until a bus arrives at a stance.

There is a bus boarding area on the outside of the sliding door. Yellow edging marks the edge of the bus boarding area. The bus arrives on the lefthand side of this area. Tactile blister tiles and a high kerb indicate where the bus door will be.

Perch seating is seating provided at all stances. This is to the right of the automatic door.

Printed timetable information is provided above the perch seating.

All stances are lit and have talking signs and information screens that give information on the next departure along with details of stance number. The button for the talking sign is to the left of the automatic door.

Information

A large electronic display showing all upcoming departures and stance numbers from the bus station is provided at either end of the bus stances. One facing the Govan Shopping Centre, the other facing Golspie Street.

Printed timetables, talking signs and digital displays with departure information provided at every bus stance.

A map of the station and a list of bus service destinations with stance numbers is located beside stance 7.

In the public plaza next to the stances, there is a city wayfinding sign with a map indicating directions to key locations in the surrounding area.

Toilets

There are no toilets available at the station.

Other information

There is full CCTV coverage throughout the station for the safety and security of all travellers.

Free WiFi is available when connecting to 'SPT Free WiFi'.

There are no facilities for left luggage.

Tickets cannot be purchased at this bus station. All bus tickets should either be purchased in advance through the bus operator or on the vehicle from the driver.
