



# Govan

## Subway Station Access Guide

### Station

A multi-level Subway station in the centre of Govan Town Centre, adjacent to Govan Bus Interchange.

The station has two platforms. One to access trains on the Inner circle and the other for trains on the Outer circle.

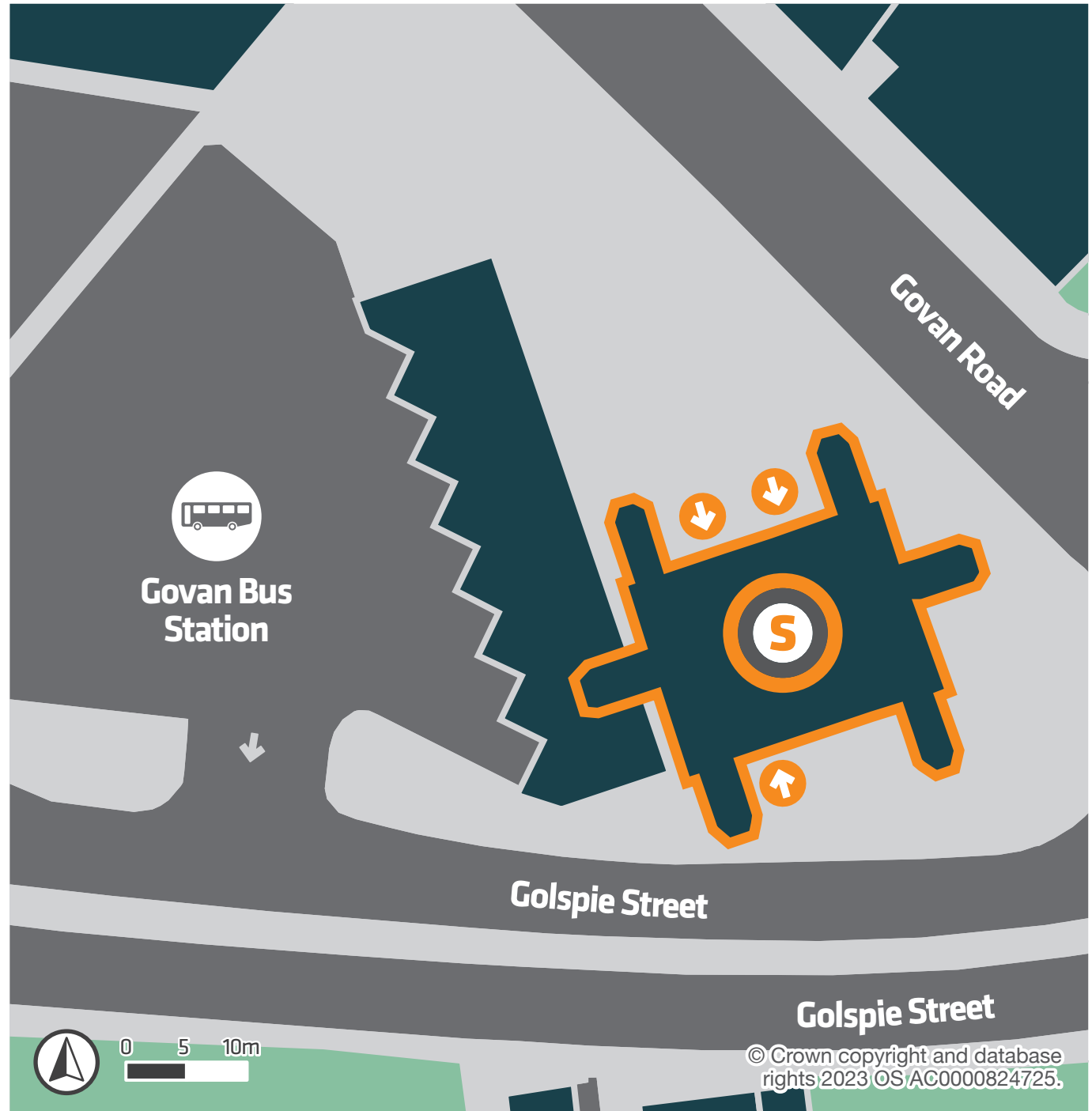
Access to the Subway Station is by two entrances: one from Golspie Street and one from the public space beside the bus station off Govan Road.

There are no designated parking facilities available at this station.

There is no designated pick up/set down area at this station.

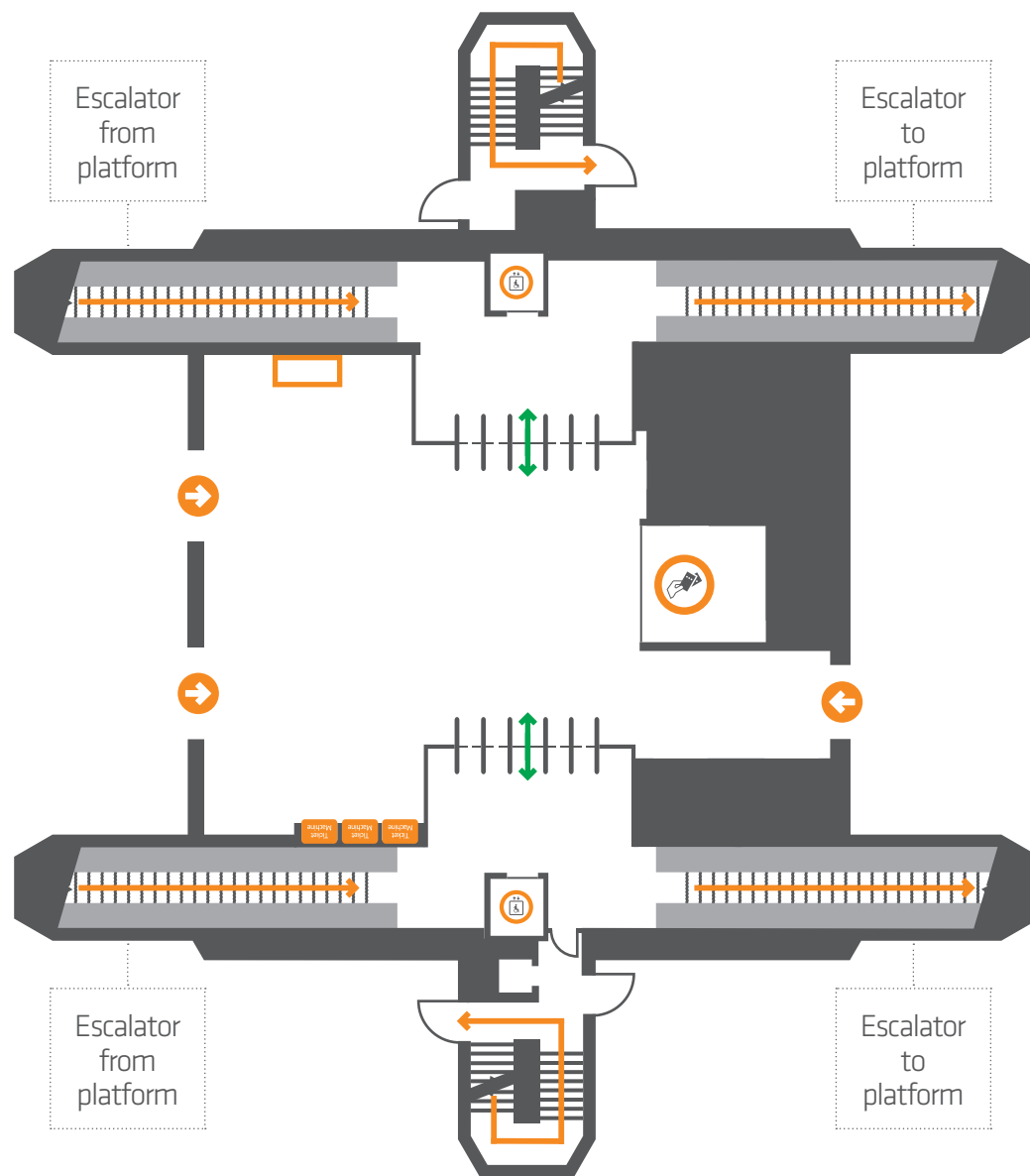
### Access to the ticketing concourse

Level step free access is provided from the Golspie Street and Govan Road entrances.

## Govan Subway station

### Ticketing concourse description

#### Ticketing concourse

The ticket office is in front of the Govan Road entrance and to the right of the Golspie Street entrance.

Ticket vending machines are located to the right on entering the station from the Govan Road entrance.

Anti-reflective, slip resistant flooring is provided throughout the station.

White wayfinding tiles in the floor guide passengers to the ticket office and ticket gate-line.

A tactile wayfinding map is located to the left on entering the station from the Govan Road entrance.

Platform and lift access is via a ticket gate-line with ticket validators. Customers should always touch their ticket on validators when entering or leaving the station.

Both the Inner and Outer ticket gate-lines are made up of five ticket gates.

Wide ticket gates are provided in both ticket gate-lines to aid passengers travelling with mobility aids, young children or bags.

Access to the Outer circle platform is from the right hand-side ticket gate-line on entry from Govan Road and left hand-side ticket gate-line on entry from Golspie Street. The wide ticket gate is to the left when facing the ticket gate-line.

#### Ticketing concourse

Access to the Inner circle platform is from the left hand-side ticket gate-line on entry from Govan Road and right hand-side ticket gate-line on entry from Golspie Street. The wide ticket gate is to the right when facing the ticket gate-line.

#### Stair or escalator access to platforms

Escalators provide access between the station concourse and the Inner circle and Outer circle platforms.

There is no fixed stair access to the platforms at this station.

Escalators may be turned off by staff on request to provide fixed stair access. The fixed flights of stairs created by the escalators when stopped are steep and long.

The escalator down to the Outer circle platform is to the left on passing through the ticket gate-line.

The escalator down to the Inner circle platform is to the right on passing through the ticket gate-line.

#### Lift access to platforms

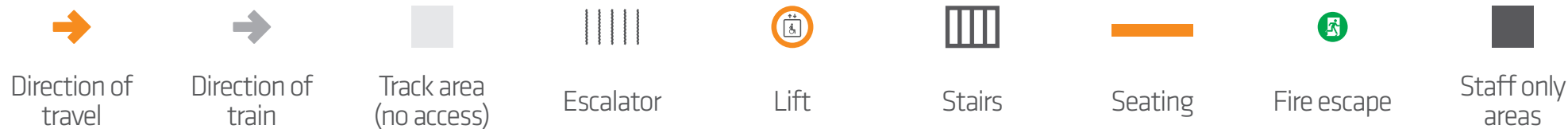
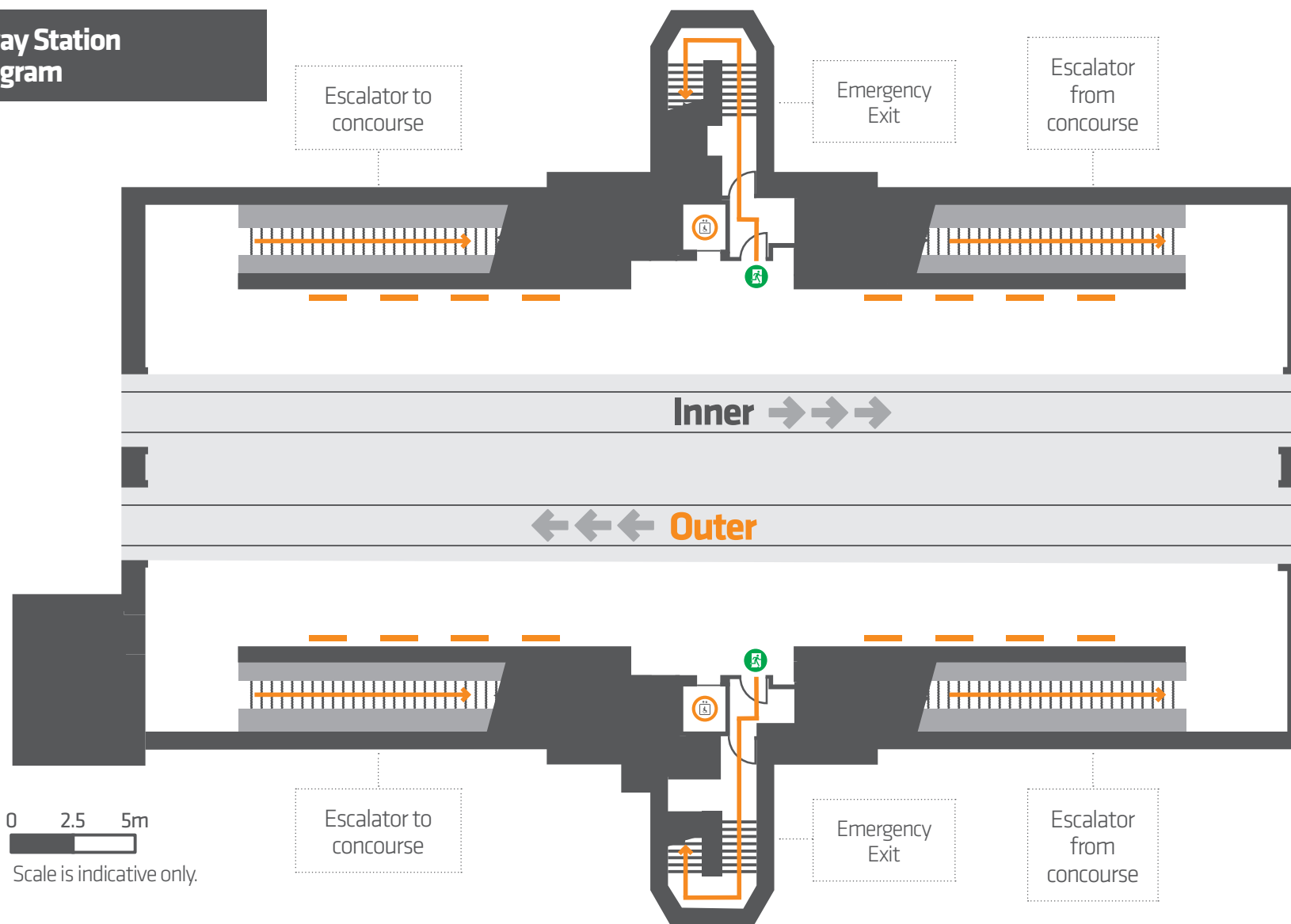
Lift access is available to both the Inner and Outer circle platforms.

Each lift is accessed by the Inner or Outer circle ticket gate-line.

The lift is positioned straight ahead from the ticket gate-line, between the up and down escalators.

Lifts are not used in the event of a fire evacuation.

## Govan Subway station

### Platform description

#### Platforms

This station has two platforms. One for the Inner circle trains and one for Outer circle trains.

Escalators to both platforms come out at the back of the platform nearest the end at which the train stops.

The lift is located at the back of the platform, halfway along the platform length. Lifts are not to be used in the event of a fire evacuation.

Platforms are tiled with anti-reflective, slip resistant tiles.

Blister tactile tiles and white edge marking are provided along the full length of both inner and outer platforms to indicate the platform edge.

Customer information systems display the wait time to next train.

#### Access between platforms

Access between platforms is via the ticketing concourse only.

The emergency escape stairs are provided in the middle of both platforms, adjacent to the lifts.

#### Other information

The station is staffed.

An induction loop is provided at the ticket office window.

Wifi is available in the station.

Govan bus interchange is located beside the subway station.

No public toilet facilities are available.

Audio information announcements are made in the station.
