1. Object of report

To recommend the Committee note the requests received for subsidised local bus services and approves the recommended actions.

2. Background

a) To delay the departure of the 2010hrs service 323 ex Brodick by 15 minutes to provide an additional summer ferry connection on Mondays – Wednesdays. Recommend: No action. The change would have an adverse effect on the remainder of the evening timetable.

Council area: North Ayrshire

b) To extend the operating hours of existing subsidised service 395 East Kilbride – Uplawmoor to service Lindsayfield, East Kilbride Recommend: No action. Alternative bus services are available within a reasonable walking distance and the likely low passenger usage would result in an excessive subsidy cost per passenger.

Council area: South Lanarkshire

c) To alter the timetable for subsidised services 32 Beith – Kilbirnie and 125 Irvine – Kilbirnie – Beith to provide better connections with rail services at Glengarnock station. Recommend: No action. Alteration of the timetable would have a detrimental effect on existing passenger journeys and would negate existing interchange options.
