1. Object of report

To notify the Committee of subsidised local bus and MyBus service contracts awarded under delegated powers. This paper affects South Ayrshire, North and South Lanarkshire, and Renfrewshire council areas.

2. Background to report

It has been necessary to permit the award of subsidised local bus and MyBus service contracts as allowed for in the Scheme of Delegations. This has been done to maintain service continuity to the travelling public.

3. Outline of proposals

Appendix 1 details the subsidised local bus and MyBus service contracts awarded since the last meeting of 22 August 2025.

4. Committee action

The Committee is recommended to note the subsidised local bus and MyBus service contracts awarded under delegated powers, in accordance with established corporate governance, financial regulation and contract standing orders.

conditions for transport contracts.

Financial consequences The award of the contracts detailed in this committee

paper will result in increased costs of £45,350 to SPT in 2025/2026 when compared to current projections for these contracts. New temporary My Bus contracts in North Lanarkshire will result in additional costs of £78,502 in 2025/2026. These costs will be fully funded

by the People and Places Programme.

services or, where service changes have resulted in impacts, mitigate the impact of a reduced commercial

local bus services.
