1. Object of report

To notify the Committee of subsidised local bus service contracts awarded utilising delegated powers.

2. Background

It has been necessary to award of subsidised local bus service contracts as allowed for in the Scheme of Delegations. This has been done in order to maintain service continuity to the travelling public.
