1. Object of report

To advise the Committee of amendments to subsidised local and MyBus bus service contracts since the last Operations Committee meeting on 3 November 2023.

2. Background to report

It is necessary to adjust subsidised local and MyBus bus service contracts to react to external factors, such as the fluidity of the commercial local bus network or road/traffic management issues to ensure, as far as possible, service continuity to the travelling public.

In addition to the contracts detailed in Appendix 1, SPT continue to adjust a number of others to align their delivery on local and national public holidays with commercial provision.

SPT ensures that all subsidised local bus service contracts are monitored and reviewed on a regular basis, in respect of contract programme and value for money.

3. Outline of proposals

The Committee is recommended to note the amendments to subsidised local bus contracts, in accordance with established corporate governance, financial regulation and contract standing orders.

4. Consequences
