### 1. Object of report

1.1 To seek approval for a proposed amendment to the 2019/20 capital programme.

#### 2. Background

2.1 Table 1 below provides a summary of the 2019/20 capital programme position as approved by the Strategy & Programmes Committee on 7 February 2020.

#### 3. Proposed amendments

3.1 At its meeting on 6 March 2020, the Partnership approved an award of contract to Airwave Solutions Ltd for the continuation of the Airwave Secure Communications Radio Service. This includes a one-off cost of up to £1,161,420 for the necessary infrastructure upgrades. At the time, it had been assumed that this cost would be funded entirely from the 2020/21 capital budget.

- 3.2 Subsequently, a milestone payment plan has been negotiated with the supplier which would include a payment of 30% on order in March 2020.
- 3.3 Additional funding of £350,000 is therefore requested in 2019/20 for Subway Operations project "Secure Mobile Operational Communications System (10552)" to facilitate this first milestone payment. The proposed total 2019/20 budget would be £450,000.
- 3.4 If the proposed amendment is approved by the Chairs Committee, then the impact on the 2019/20 programme will be as detailed in Table 2 below.
