



Glasgow Subway Conditions of Travel – Request for amendment

1. Object of report

This report is to advise the Partnership of correspondence received requesting an amendment to the Subway's Conditions of Travel.

2. Background

The Subway's Conditions of Travel, which were approved by the Partnership on 7 December 2012, do not allow for the carriage of animals with the exception of assistance dogs and small animals in secure containers.

Correspondence has been received requesting that SPT's policy in relation to the carriage of animals be reviewed and brought into line with other forms of public transport and underground services in the UK which allow dogs to be transported.

3. Outline of proposals

In terms of paragraph 3.8.4 of the Standing Orders, it is proposed that the correspondence be remitted to the Operations Committee for consideration, with a view to making a recommendation on the request to the Partnership.

4. Partnership action

The Partnership is asked to note that the correspondence in relation to a request for a review of the Subway's Conditions of Travel to allow the carriage of dogs will be remitted to the Operations Committee for consideration.
