There was submitted a report (tabled) of 6 August 2007 by the Assistant Chief Executive (Customer Services) advising members of proposals to enter into a partnership arrangement with Visit Scotland and Renfrewshire Council to provide public transport and tourist information in Paisley town centre in a more efficient and cost effective manner.

After consideration and having noted

- (1) the terms propose by the Landlord;
- (2) the requirement for SPT to vacate the current premises by the end of September 2007; and
- (3) that a receipt of £20,000 would be forthcoming from the landlord,

the committee, on grounds of urgency

- (a) approved the proposals as outlined in the report which would enable SPT to make ongoing revenue savings in the region of £15,000 per annum; and
- (b) agreed to amend the Capital Programme for this project to £25,000.
