

## Asset Transfer Requests Annual Report 2021/22

### Background

Community organisations have the right to submit requests to local authorities, Scottish Ministers and public service authorities for buildings or land they feel could be managed more effectively. These rights are encompassed under Part 5 of the Community Empowerment Act (2015). Community groups are permitted to request ownership, lease or other rights to these assets. SPT alongside other public authorities must consider requests based upon a set list of standards including eligibility requirements; all of which are outlined within the Community Empowerment Act (2015).
